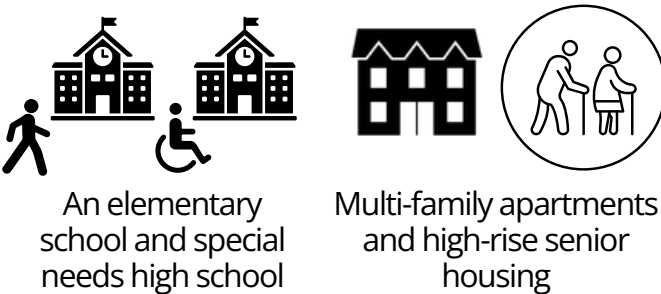
WHERE IS THERE OIL DRILLING IN MY NEIGHBORHOOD?

WHY IS OIL AND GAS DRILLING NEAR OUR HOMES AND SCHOOLS A PROBLEM FOR OUR HEALTH?

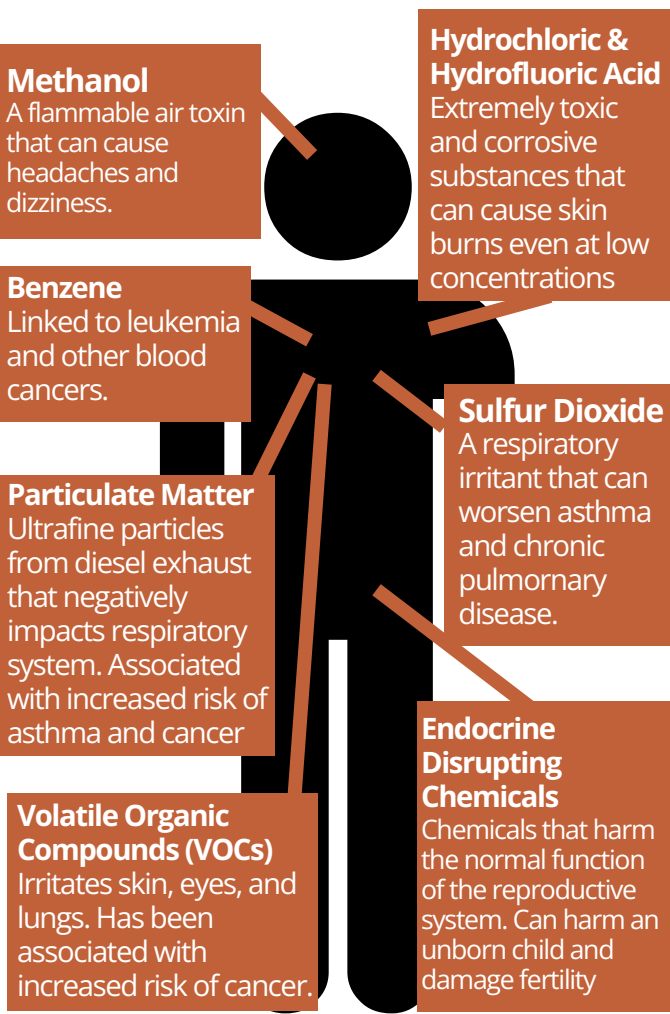


In November 2025, two Notices of Violation were issued at Murphy; one for violating permit conditions barring the use of equipment within 1000' of a school.
